**Minutes of the Tele Conference Held on 24.05.2021 on,
Jagananna Thodu with Joint Collectors (VWS&D), Municipal
Commissioners, PDs DRDA, PDs MEPMA and LDMs**

The Director GVWV&VSWS Department has conducted Teleconference with all the Joint Collectors (VWS&D), Municipal Commissioners, PDs DRDA, PDs MEPMA and LDMs on progress of Jagananna Thodu on 24.05.2021. He explained about the Progress and dissatisfaction & instructions of the Secretary to Hon'ble Chief Minister on the progress of Jagananna Thodu and PM SVANidhi. The Hon'ble Chief Minister has already instructed to achieve the target as promised by the GVWV&VSWS Department. After detailed discussions and deliberations he has issued following instructions:

- All the Joint Collectors (VWS&D) are requested to achieve the target of 3,26,268 in addition to the existing progress and the District wise details are Annexed to these minutes. They shall collect, sponsor to Banks, open the accounts if necessary, complete the documentation and get sanctions before 28.05.2021 and ready to disburse on 08th June 2021.
- After launching of the Jagananna Thodu Program on 8th June 2021 the appropriate message shall go to the beneficiaries contact number about disbursement of loan amount.
- Continuously monitor with Village/Ward Secretariats, Bankers, LDMs, PDs DRDA and PDs MEPMA and achieve the targets by 28.05.2021 without fail.
- PDs DRDA and PDs MEPMA are requested to cover all eligible beneficiaries including shop owners up to 10' x 10' built up area.
- All the Joint Collectors (VWS&D) are requested to ensure deploying of staff to the Bank Branches especially more number of persons to the DCCB Banks for assisting in opening

of accounts and completion of documentation.

- PDs DRDA and PDs MEPMA are requested to complete the Reverification of applications immediately duly coordinating with the Welfare Assistants of Village/Ward Secretariats.
- PDs MEPMA are requested to deploy sufficient number of staff to the DCCB Branches for assisting Branch Managers in opening of accounts & completion of loan documentation.

CEO, SERP:

The CEO, SERP has explained the progress and seriousness of the CMO. The PDs DRDA shall ensure to achieve the target given by the GVWV&VSWS Department. If any person is not willing out of the data sponsored to the Banks previously may sponsor alternative persons and full fill the targets. PDs DRDA shall understand the seriousness and sponsor more number of applications to the Banks. All Rural Women may sponsor to Streenidhi.

Further, PDs DRDA are requested to submit the progress daily so that same may be furnished to the Secretary to the Hon'ble Chief Minister and the GVWV&VSWS Department.

MD, MEPMA:

MD, MEPMA has explained the PM SVANidhi progress and she requested the APCOB to consider the submission of loan documents along with account opening forms to save the time and to avoid visiting of two times by the beneficiary to the DCCB Bank Branches.

All the Joint Collectors (VWS&D) are requested to concentrate on Jagananna Thodu duly coordinating with Streenidhi and APCOB. The Secretary to the Hon'ble Chief Minister may also review the progress of Jagananna Thodu on 28th May 2021 since the Hon'ble Chief Minister will launch the 2nd phase of Jagananna Thodu on 8th June 2021. The daily Teleconference will be conducted until achievement of the target i.e., 28th May 2021.
